

SOP FOR ROYAL SUPER 50 SCHOLARSHIP TEST (2026 - 27)

The Royal Super 50 Scholarship Test (2026-27) offers academically exceptional students, regardless of their social or economic background, the opportunity to receive full financial support for their education. This includes waivers for school fees, hostel fees, and transport fees. The scholarship is awarded based on academic performance, commitment to excellence and fulfillment of the eligibility criteria.

1. Eligibility Criteria: For Grade 2 to 9 (2026-27)

- **For students applying for Grade 2 to 5:** Students who have scored **90% or higher aggregate** in their Midterm (Half Yearly) examination of academic year (2025-26) are eligible to appear for the **Royal Super 50 Scholarship Test** for grade 2 to 5.
- **For students applying for Grade 6 to 9:** Students who have scored **85% or higher** in their Midterm (Half Yearly) examination of academic year (2025-26) are eligible to appear for the **Royal Super 50 Scholarship Test** for grade 6 to 9.
- **Age Criteria:** As per NEP guidelines.

2. Scholarship Benefits:

- **Full Fee Waiver:** Complete waiver of school fees which includes- (Enrolment Fees, Development Fees, Activity Fees & Tuition Fees) for the academic year 2026-27.
- **Hostel & Transport Facility:** Transport fees and, if applicable, hostel fees will be waived for scholarship recipients.
- **Continued Waiver Criteria:** Students must maintain 90% in the Annual Exam in grades 2 to 5, and 85% in grades 6 to 9 to retain the scholarship in subsequent years.

3. Scholarship Test Details:

- **Test Date:** First Sunday of December, 2025 and a Subsequent Test on the Second Sunday of January, 2026.
- **Test Duration:** 2 Hours 45 Minutes (165 minutes)
- **Number of Questions:** 100 MCQ (1 mark each) + Essay Writing (10 Marks)
- **Negative Marking:** 1/4 mark for incorrect answers of MCQs.
- **Interview:** Shortlisted students will undergo a personal interview for selection.

4. Syllabus Breakdown:

- **For Grade 2-5:**
 - Aptitude & General Knowledge: 25 Questions
 - Mathematics: 25 Questions
 - Environmental Science: 25 Questions
 - English: 25 Questions
 - Essay Writing: 10 Marks (30 minutes)
 - Personal Interview: 40 Marks (15 minutes)

- **Grade 6-9:**
 - Aptitude & General Knowledge: 25 Questions
 - Mathematics: 25 Questions
 - Science & Social Studies: 25 Questions
 - English: 25 Questions
 - Essay Writing: 10 Marks (30 minutes)
 - Personal Interview: 40 Marks (15 minutes)

5. Registration Process:

- **Registration Mode:**
 - Register online through website www.rgs.edu.in.
- **Registration Fee:** No Cost

6. Conducting the Examination:

- The test will be conducted on RGS campus during school hours 10:00 AM to 12:45 PM (Sunday).
- The exam will assess critical thinking and problem-solving skills.

7. Result Declaration & Scholarship Award:

- Result will be announced within 10 working days after the test.
- Tie-breaker: In case of a tie, interviews will be conducted to determine the final 50 scholarship holders.

8. Sample Question Paper:

- A set of sample question papers will be provided to registered students for preparation after completing registration.

9. Parental Consent & Documentation:

- Parental consent is mandatory for all applicants.
- Parents must provide necessary documents (identity proof) and mid-term (half yearly) report card for verification.

10. Ethical Standards:

- Any form of unfair means during the exam will result in immediate disqualification.

11. Data Privacy:

- All personal and academic data will be treated with confidentiality in compliance with privacy regulations.

12. Parental Engagement:

- Parents of scholarship recipients will be invited to participate in workshops and support programs to enhance the academic journey of their children.

13. Undertaking: At the time of registration, all applicants must agree to the terms and Conditions and commit to abide by them.
